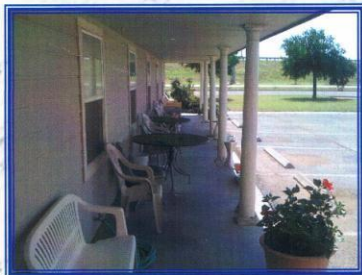

What is the ARC

The Recovery Center is a 501 (c) (3) non-profit long -term shelter for men recovering from alcoholism and/or drug addiction.

Our mission is to provide a safe, recovery-oriented environment for these men to begin again. Our focus is on accountability and responsibility.

We Provide:

- ♦ Good Nutrition
- ♦ A Place To Rest
- ♦ Loving Support

Alcoholics Anonymous meetings are held at the center three times a week by local AA members.



History of the Recovery Center

The Recovery Center was founded in September 1971 by a group of local businessmen. The idea came from the ARC in Amarillo, Texas. The need for a recovery shelter was recognized following the May 11th, 1970 Lubbock tornado that left devastation in the downtown area.

"Mama" Dot Patterson directed the center for 25 years.

Don and Barbara Russell became the directors in October 1996. Under their ^{IN Oct. 1996 a new 18} direction, a new 18-bed wing was added and the original structure was completely rehabilitated. This was funded in part by grants from the City of Lubbock CDBG ESG , Lubbock Osteopathic Fund Inc., E.A. Franklin Trust, The CH Foundation, Helen Jones Foundation, South Plains Foundation, South Plains Volunteer Services Inc., and private donations of materials, labor, and money by businesses and individuals.

Hours

Applications are accepted between the hours of 9am and 6pm CST Monday through Friday.

The Center is staffed 24 hours a day 7 days a week.

Admission Requirements

- Have a desire to stop using alcohol and/or drugs.
- Willing to work full-time.
- Clients asked to contribute weekly.
- Residents are required to attend 6 weekly AA meetings (transportation to meetings provided by Recovery Center).
- Clients clean center daily.
- Commitment to stay a minimum of 3-6 months.
- Residents may stay up to 1 year.



Services Provided

- Structured, home-like environment with an emphasis on good recovery and building healthy habits.
- Two men per room.
- 3 nutritious meals daily.
- Free laundry facilities.
- All linens provided.
- Phone available for personal calls.
- Conveniently located downtown by the main Citibus terminal.
